People at risk

Holiday makers using our touring caravan park.

Guest visitors to the park.

Nearby static holiday park residents and visitors.

Evaluation / Remove / Reduce / Protect from risk

What is the risk?

Smoking on the premises; naked flames, gas bottles and BBQs near caravans, cars or buildings.

Who is at risk?

Fire can spread in dry conditions and combustible gases on-board caravans; everyone is at risk.

Action taken to remove and reduce the hazards that may cause a fire?

Dry leaves and grass are minimised around the park – reducing fire risks.

1 car parked per caravan to keep space – reducing risk of fire spreading.

Seasonal pitches disconnect electric hook-up when not staying at the park - reducing fire risks.

No camp fires are allowed under any circumstances, BBQs must be kept off the ground and temporary ban imposed during extreme dry conditions – removing fire risk.

Action taken to remove or reduce risk of fire to people?

People staying at the park are made aware of fire extinguisher point. Our fire assembly point (with clear signage) is located on the play area away from the site.
